STR Behavioral Health – Bucks County is a leading outpatient center for substance use and mental health disorder treatment. We offer partial hospitalization and intensive outpatient care, with supportive housing options. Both treatment programs are supported by a psychiatric provider, licensed clinicians, and experienced professionals. Medication-assisted treatment (MAT) options are offered at all levels of care

Levels of Care

Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP)

PHP is offered Monday through Saturday. Each client in PHP attends therapy sessions with a clinician twice per week to navigate their individual needs, as well as a psychiatric evaluation and medication management follow-up on a weekly basis.

Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP)

IOP services are offered Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday. Each IOP client attends therapy sessions with a clinician once per week, as well as a psychiatric evaluation and a follow-up monthly.

Supportive Housing

Our supportive housing program offers structure, emotional support, and practical life skills for PHP and IOP clients. Each residence has a certified recovery specialist (CRS) to assist with employment, housing, transportation, and community integration, ensuring a smooth transition to life after treatment.
